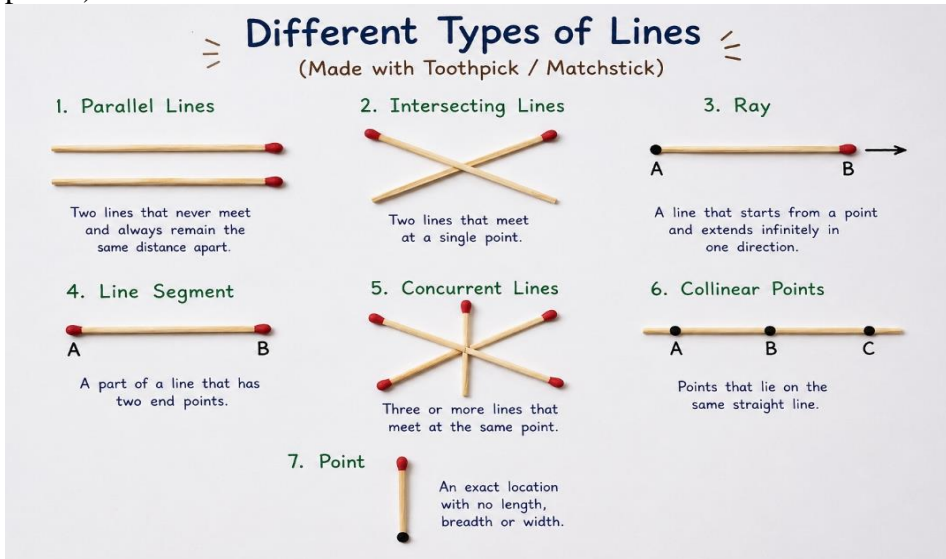

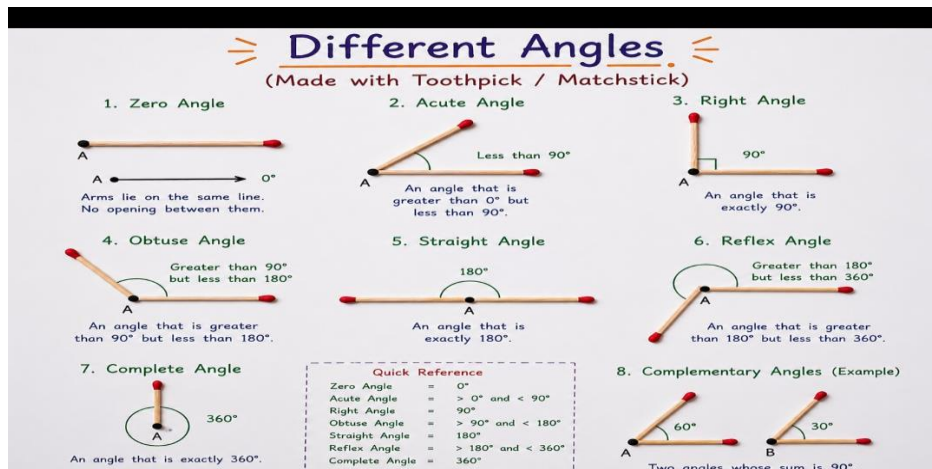

Oxygen is the 'hero' of this reaction, we call it **Oxidation**."

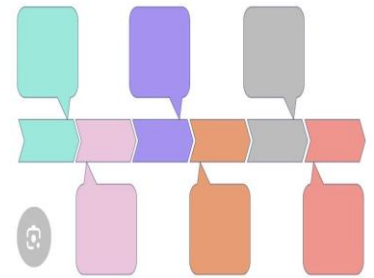
